However, the efficiency of the capacity building activities that will be undertaken by the Parties could be improved by the exchange of experience between the actors involved in capacity building activities using digital (eg. elearning) as well as more traditionnal tools such as networking, exchange of good practices, provision of methodology and case studies mainly on a regional basis.
