





1. Environmental: ✓ Avoid buying the production of waste products with a longer shelf life or rechargeable products ✓ Reduced consumption of resources ✓ Good use of energy consumption in the selection of products ✓ Purchasing products easy to recycle ✓ Products exclude hazardous substances to the environment and human health	Ecoeficiency National accounts Public investment Projects - PIP
 ✓ That product inputs come from a recycling process 2. Socials: ✓ Promotion of socio-labor integration ✓ Maintaining working conditions ✓ Supporting the social economy ✓ Compliance with legislation - non-discrimination, equal opportunities, etc. 	Many of these criteria are in an early stage. Some are more progress than others, but not apply to all public procurement
3. Ethical: ✓ Products and vendors to ensure decent working conditions throughout the supply chain of the product and service performance ✓ Respect the conventions of the International Labour Organization ✓ Guaranteed no use of child labor ✓ Transparency in the origin of products and traceability ✓ Supporting products and fair trade organizations as an alternative	in the country



Green growth initiatives

- National public investment system green (Formulate projects related to ecosystem services and biodiversity)
- Environmental National Accouting:
 - Coordination with international organizativos (ONU-Banco Mundial-CEPAL) and nationals (INEI - MEF)
 - WAVES Project (Wealth accounting and valuation of ecosystem services promote sustainable development, tending the use of national accounts to measure and plan economic growth including the value of natural resources)
 - EVA Project (environmental value accounting assessment gain a better understanding of changes in the capital of ecosystems and human welfare implications)




Green growth initiatives

- National Forest conservation Program for the mitigation of Climate Change for the permanent protection of 54 milloin ha of forest.
 Supporting indigenous people and promoting new sustainable activities, more than ony wood.
- BIOFIN: Pilot global project from UNDP.
- ECOTRADE (Program Policy Support Peruvian Export Promotion of Organic Products) from local governments.
- PAGE (Partnership for Action on Green Economy) with green jobs
- Peer to Peer Program (For an inclusive and sustainable development in Latin -Fiscal Policy)

 Supreme Decree No. 009-2009-MINAM "Eco-Efficiency Measures for Public Sector".

Nº 009-2009-MINAM

MEDIDAS DE ECOEFICIENCIA PARA EL SECTOR PÚBLICO

EL PRESIDENTE DE LA REPUBLICA

CONSIDERANDO

Que, mediante el numeral 7.5 del artículo 7º de la Ley Nº 29293, Ley de Presupuesto del Sector Público pare al Año Fiscal 2009, modificado por el Decreto de Urgencia Nº 017-2009, se determinó que las entidades públicas dispongan, a través de sus respectivas Oficinas Generales de Administración la adeogrón de Medidas de Ecoeficiencia tales como ahorro de consumo de energía, agua y papel, así como gastos de combustible en sus vehiculos, entre otras, las cuales deben ser aprobadas dentro del primer timestre de cada año y ser publicadas en el portal institucional de la entidad, así como sus resultados de manera mensual;





Que, la implementación de las Medidas de Ecoeficiencia permitirán mejorar la calidad del servicio público, ahorrar recursos materiales, energía y permitirán minimizar la generación de residuos, lo que se traducirá en la liberación de recursos económicos que pueden destinarse a los fines primordiales del desarrollo sostenible;

Que, las crecientes "necesidades" de los seres humanos de las actuales y futuras generaciones y las mayores l'imitaciones" del ambiente para satisfacerias obligan a la adopción de patrones de producción y consumo sostenibles, que se fortalezcan con políticas públicas firmes y con una gestión pública consecuente con el modelo de desarrollo sastenible:

Que, finalmente y de acuerdo con lo establecido en el numeral 7.5 del artículo 7º de la Ley № 29289, Ley del Presupuesto del Sector Público para el Año Fiscal 2009, modificado por el Decreto de Urgencia № 017-2009, el proyecto normativo cuenta con la opinión previa favorable del Ministerio de Economía y Finanzas;

De conformidad con lo dispuesto en el inciso 8) del Artículo 118° de la Constitución Política del Perú y la Ley N° 29158, Ley Orgánica del Poder Ejecutivo; The purpose of the Decree is to approve the eco-efficiency measures that have the effect of savings in public spending, according to the provisions of paragraph 7.5 of Article 7 of Law No. 29289, Law of Public Sector Budget (FY 2009)

In the following years, the consideration of eco-efficiency measures for public sector (SD No. 009-2009-MINAM) are reflected in the additional provisions of the budgets laws.



REGULATIONS, DIRECTIVES AND AGREEMENTS

Eco-Efficiency Guide for public sector institutions.



The aim of the guide is to facilitate the process of identification, implementation and monitoring of actions arising from the application of the concepts of eco-efficiency.

It also provides a list of suppliers of clean energy, water, office supplies, among others.



REGULATIONS, DIRECTIVES AND AGREEMENTS

 Agreement between Supervisory Agency the State Procurement (OSCE - Peru) and Procurement and Public Contracting (ChileCompra - Chile)



Third clause:

...The OSCE is interested in the information and training that "ChileCompra" can deliver, especially in matters of the framework agreement, tools for improving and standardizing procurement, sustainable procurement, among others

 Project "Technical cooperation between Chile and Peru to the development of sustainable public procurement in both countries." In the framework of the Program Peer to Peer - P2P (ECLAC, ILPES, GIZ)








 Project "Stimulating Demand and supply of sustainable products through sustainable public procurement and Eco-labeling" - Proposal by UNEP (Evaluation Stage)





MEASURES ADOPTED INTO THE MINISTRY

 Directive No. 002-2011-SG-MINAM "Eco-Efficiency Policy Measures in the Ministry of the Environment"



Establish eco-efficiency measures to improve the quality of public services, generating savings in public spending that affects compliance MINAM budget targets, contributing to environmental preservation.



Key issues



Challenges/barriers

a) Lack of an agreed definition of sustainable public procurement.

b) Peru approved the Supreme Decree (184-2008-EF) regulatory of State Procurement Law (No. 1017). Which states the guiding principles procurement (article 4) linked to sustainability. However, the practical implementation of the criteria is situated in a initial phase.



d) Implement sustainability criteria in public procurement (ex. technical specifications) made by government social programs such as Qaly Warma, Community Kitchens, among others.

e) Promoting environmental sustainability criteria in specific interinstitutional agreements on public procurement.

- f) Learning from projects implemented in international experience
- g)Enhanced the stakeholders engagement
