Loss of Biodiversity %

Birds North America: **25%** 1970-1918

Insects

Global: 2.5% por año: **20%** in 10 años.

Germany: **75%** flying insects, protected areas, in 25 años

Puerto Rico: 98% terrestrial, 80% arboreal, en 35 años.

Mexico: **80%** dry forest 1970- 2018, WWF.

Vertebrates Global: 60% 1970-2018

- invasion of alien species








