- 250 000 public authorities in the EU
- Public procurement is responsible for 18% of GDP
- The Dutch government:


60 billion annually, 10 billion on a national level







SPP IN THE NETHERLANDS








Figure 7: Environmental Aspects cited by national governments as priority

Contributing to:


- o International, national and local sustainability objectives (biodiversity and other)

o Influencing private and corporate buying behaviour




Directive 2014: Most Economically Advantageous Tender (MEAT), LCC & Innovation partnerships

For example: Corporate wear / other textiles





Linkages to drivers of biodiversity loss




'Biodiversity Heat map' Direct & indirect linkages to drivers of biodiversity loss






Potential biodiversity impacts.....covered by SPP criteria (minimum/award/contract)?






Biodiversity in SPP Materiality matrix
