- Belgian CHM partnership started in 1999
- Till 2005 mainly focused on CHM development in development countries
- First call for projects on CEPA in 2005
- Participatory development of 2008-2012 programme during 2007 partner meeting

- CHM reinforcement
 - Training on use of CHM extended to national training of partners
 - Projects to develop national CHM network
 - Projects to develop sections of CHM



Calls for in situ CEPA projects

1. Open or directed
2. Competitive
3. One Call/year

Orientated around AICHI Target 1 :

By 2020, at the latest, people are aware of the values of biodiversity and the steps they can take to conserve and use it sustainably.

Call 2014

Themes for CEPA projects

- 1. Study on suitable indicators for a baseline study (if not yet in NBSAP)**
- 2. Baseline study on the perception of biodiversity based on the indicators chosen.**
- 3. Public awareness project, which aim is to raise the awareness of target audience chosen**
- 4. 2018-2019: Monitoring of progress by doing baseline study again.**


Eligibility

 - 3. Mekong Delta**
- 3. South-South cooperation on regional themes**
