

# REPORT TO THE CONVENTION ON BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE MALDIVES TO CELEBRATE INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY 2007

#### Introduction

Maldives being a party to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), has been celebrating International Day for Biological Diversity since 2002. The purpose of celebrating this day is to increase understanding and awareness on biodiversity issues. Also to highlight the threats faced by all living things due to human actions.

The activities linked with Biodiversity day this year are specially targeted to school children who will in future play an important role in taking steps to conserve the biological diversity of our country and also create public awareness on biodiversity issues.

The activities carried out to celebrate Biodiversity Day are as follows:

#### 1- Official Meeting to mark the International Day for Biological Diversity 2007

A special meeting to mark the International Day for Biological Diversity was organized by the Environment Research Centre (ERC) of the Ministry of Environment, Energy and Water on the morning of 22 May 2007. The meeting was attended by the Minister of Environment, Energy and Water, Mr. Ahmed Abdulla, Acting Minister of Higher Education, Employment and Social Security, Mr. Abdul

Rasheed Hussein and other government officials. The chief guest of the meeting was the Minister of Environment, Energy and Water, Mr. Ahmed Abdulla. In his speech, the Minister spoke about the critical importance of environmental sustainability and protection of the rich biodiversity of the country.


## Kasim and the Hawksbill Turtle: A Children's Storybook

#### 2- Reef tour in Submarine

The Environment Research Centre organized a reef sight-seeing tour in Tourist Submarine for school children on the morning of 22 May 2007 in the capital island, Male'. The purpose of the trip was to show the children the diversity of the coral reefs and explain about the vulnerability of the reef ecosystem to climate change.

A special video session was held to students who participated in the reef tour. A video documentary on a healthy reef and CBD video on Biodiversity and Climate Change was shown to the students. Resource personnel from Environment Research Centre and Marine Research Centre were present inside the submarine to inform the students on the importance of reef ecosystem to an island country like Maldives and the threats faced by coral reefs due to increase in the sea temperatures. Submarine reef tour was a huge success as the students got to explore the reef and got first-hand experience about the reef ecosystem and their vulnerability to climate change.

#### **3- Marine Museum Tour**

A marine museum tour was organized for school children on the afternoon of 22 May 2007. Students were taken to the marine museum of the Marine Research Centre, to show the fishes and marine animals on display and to explain about the species of fishes and corals found in the Maldivian reefs.
