



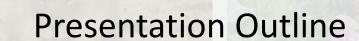

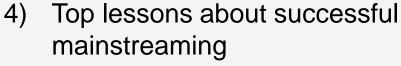

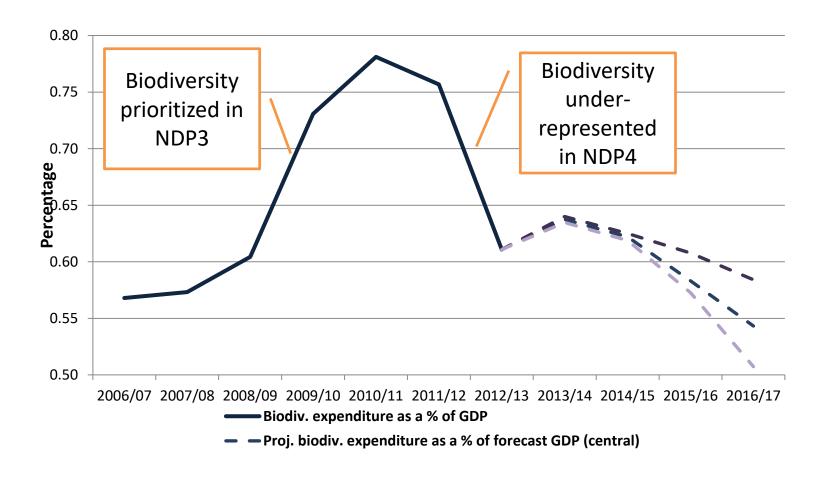


## COUNTRY PROGRESS AND CHALLENGES

#### Progress:

- NBSAP 2 strategy is being implemented through the steering committee from various institutions
- Improving capacity for and stock taking of challenges of biodiversity mainstreaming. A strategy was developed for implementation through NBSAP Steering Committee.
- Incorporation of biodiversity mainstreaming into NDP5. "Improve status of biodiversity by safeguarding ecosystems, species and genetic diversity".
- Challenges
- Small budget in MET and few sources

#### Top change achieved or expected

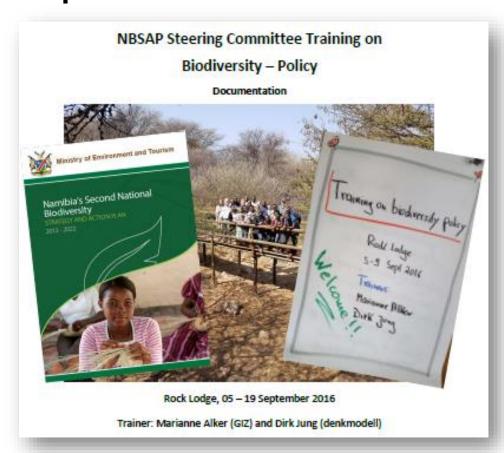
- Aichi Targets addressed

- Strong coordination among institutions.

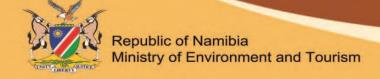
# Top lessons about successful mainstreaming
