

5. General information on access to Cairo, Egypt



Cairo is serviced by the Cairo International Airport which is located in Heliopolis (22 km from central Cairo). Taxis are available at the airport and there is a shuttle-bus service every 30 minutes.

Taxis and limousines are readily available for hire just outside the terminal to Downtown Cairo. Also, there is a shuttle bus service available in the airport which can take you to several locations in the area, including downtown. The price for shuttle bus service for groups or single passengers to downtown Cairo is as follows:

Destination	Shuttle per passenger	For Groups (from 1 to 7 passengers) or Private use

6. Visa information

Participants from the following countries are required to be in possession of a visa prior to arrival: Afghanistan, Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Islamic Republic of Iran, Israel, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Macau, Malaysia, Moldova, Montenegro, Morocco, Pakistan, Palestine, Philippines, Russian Federation, Serbia, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Thailand, The Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan and all African countries.

Participants requiring an entry visa for Egypt are strongly advised to contact the nearest Egyptian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue, upon request, invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

7. Health requirements

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers coming from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission. The following countries and areas are regarded as countries with risk of yellow fever transmission: Africa: Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, Côte d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Niger, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia. America: Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, French Guiana, Guyana, Panama, Peru, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, Venezuela.

8. Hotel information

The Secretariat has booked rooms at the Shepheard Hotel for all participants in order to facilitate the workshop and, as such, is requesting that participants stay at the same hotel. Please be advised that participants may be required to work on exercises in the evenings, etc. As accommodations have been reserved for participants at the Shepheard Hotel, the Secretariat will not reimburse the costs of other hotels.

9. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA)

Sponsored participants will receive, according to UN rules, a portion of their DSA to cover supper and incidental costs. The costs of accommodation for sponsored participants, including breakfast and lunch, will be paid directly to the hotel by the organizers.

10. Field Trip

As a field visit is planned, participants are strongly advised to bring appropriate clothing and footwear. Participants may also wish to include some long-sleeved shirts or blouses that provide greater protection against possible insect bites. Participants are recommended to use insect repellent sprays and creams, as appropriate.

11. Official languages in Cairo, Egypt

The official language in Egypt is Arabic, English and/or French are generally understood.

12. Weather and time zone information



In December, temperatures in Cairo usually range between a maximum of $+20^{\circ}$ C in the daytime and a minimum of $+10^{\circ}$ C at night. The standard time zone will be GMT + 2 hours. Current weather conditions can be found at: http://www.worldweather.org/059/c00248.htm.

220 volts, 50 Hertz. This two-wire plug is ungrounded and has two round prongs.



14. Currency



The currency in Egypt is the Egyptian Pound (EGP £). The current exchange rate is US 1 = EGP5.53 and (Euro) 1 = EGP£7.03.
