

6. General information on access to Nadi, Fiji



Nadi is serviced by the Nadi International Airport in Nadi, Fiji (about 8 km from Nadi Town). It is located on the West of Viti Levu and the capital Suva is located to the East. 7. Visa information



Participants from countries listed below do not require an entry visa for Fiji all others and are strongly advised to contact the nearest Fijian diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure.

Citizens of the following countries **do not** require a visa for Fiji for a stay of up to 90 days:

Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Australia, Bahamas, Bangladesh, Barbados, Belgium, Belize, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Dominica, Estonia, Finland, France, Gambia, Germany, Ghana, Greece, Grenada, Guyana, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Israel, Italy, Ireland, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Kiribati, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lesotho, Luxembourg, Malawi, Malaysia, Maldives, Malta, Mauritius, Mexico, Micronesia (Federated States of), Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Pacific Islands, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Switzerland, Tanzania (United Republic of), Thailand, The Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Tuvalu, Uganda, Ukraine, United Kingdom Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Uruguay, Venezuela, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will issue upon request invitation letters to be attached to the visa applications.

8. Health Requirements

A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers entering Fiji within 10 days of having stayed overnight or longer in countries with risk of yellow fever transmission.

9. Hotel information

10. Payment of the Daily Subsistence Allowances (DSA)

The Secretariat will cover the cost of hotel accommodation for sponsored delegates, including breakfast and lunch. SCBD will also provide sponsored delegates a portion of the DSA to cover the costs for dinner and incidental expenses.

11. Official languages in Fiji

The official language in Fiji is English, however, Bau Fijian, and Hindustani are also spoken.

12. Weather and time zone information

14. Currency



The currency in Fiji is the Fijian Dollar (FJD \$). The current exchange rate as at 21 January is US \$1.00 = FJD \$1.84 and = \$1.00 = FJD \$2.39.
