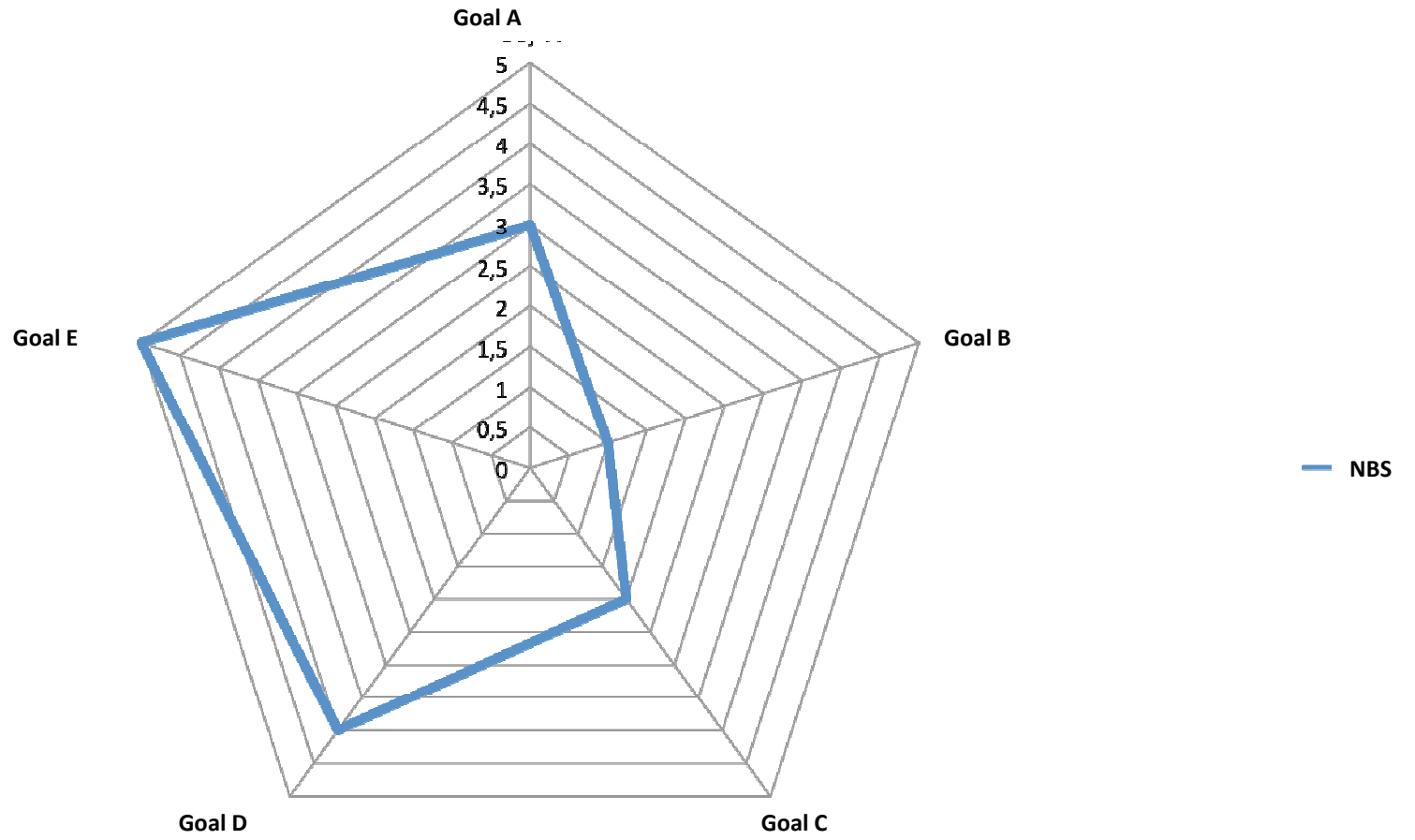


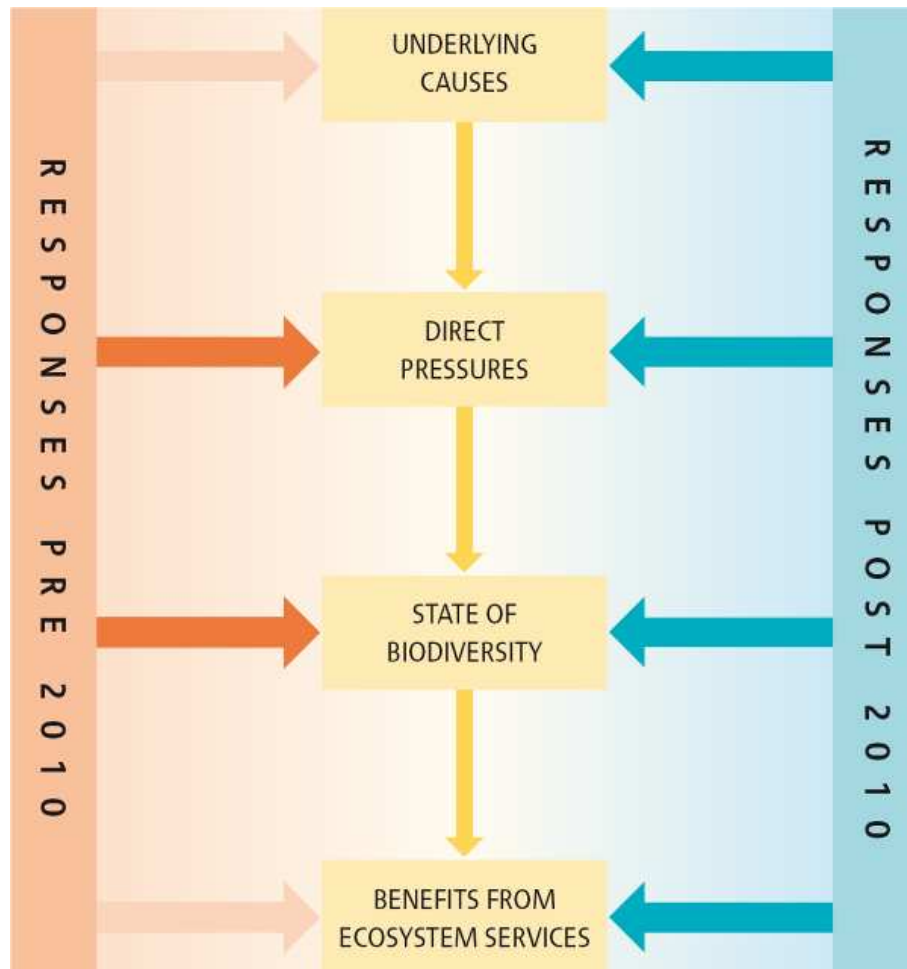
1. Quick assessment of current NBSAP

- Working as a country team, assess the coverage of the 5 new Strategic Plan Goals by your latest **existing NBSAP at adoption** using the pentagon diagram provided;
- Use the following scale (0-5) to assess each Strategic Goal on the pentagon (use **blue** colour):
 - » 0: No coverage of this strategic goal at all
 - » 1: Strategic goal partly covered (<35%)
 - » 2: Strategic goal around 50% covered (35-50%)
 - » 3: Strategic goal mostly covered (>65%)
 - » 4: Strategic goal fully covered (100%)
 - » 5: Strategic goal more than 100% covered.

A. Address the **underlying causes** of biodiversity loss (mainstreaming)

B. Reduce the **direct pressures** and promote sustainable use

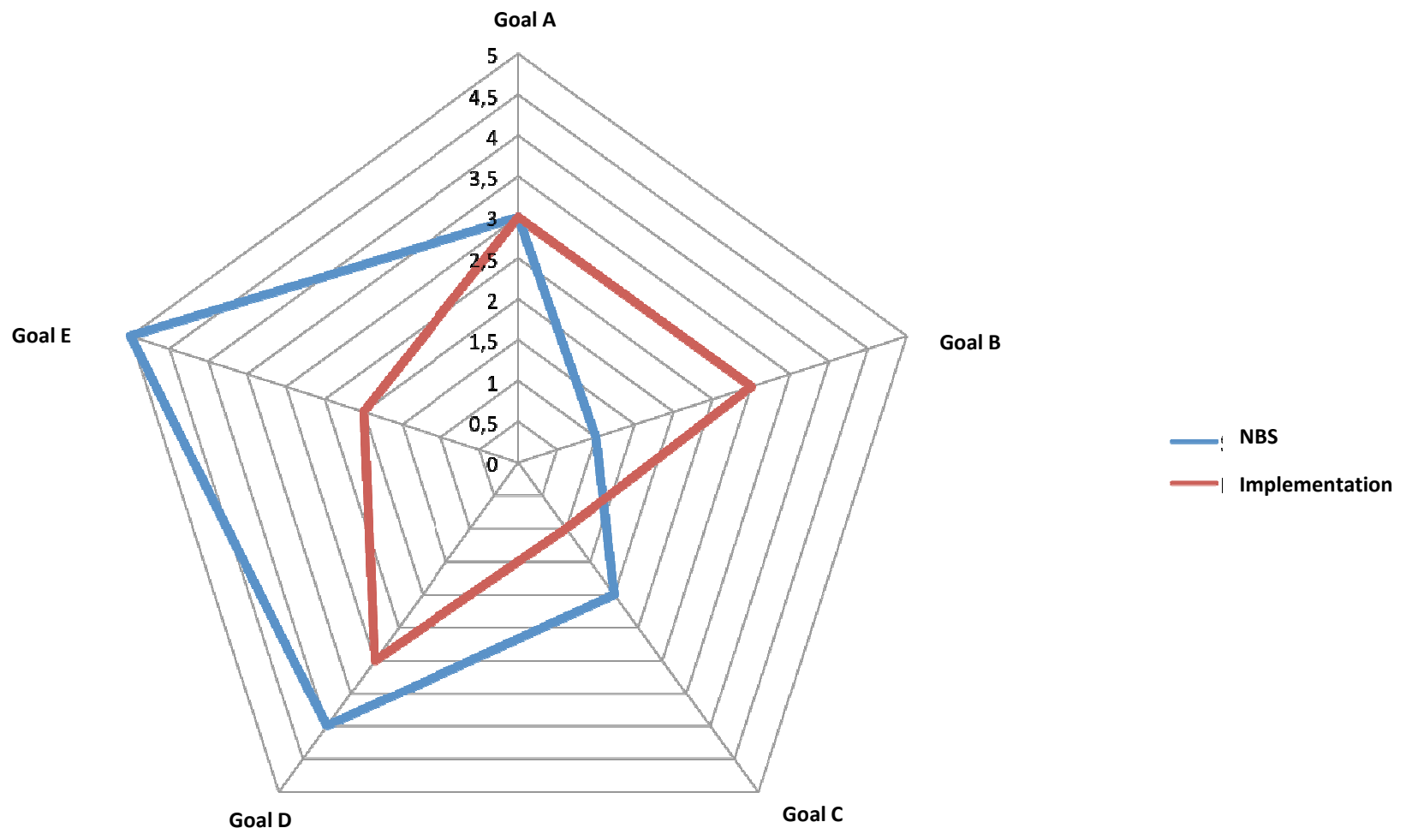
C. Directly safeguard ecosystems, species and genetic diversity

D. Enhance the **benefits** to all from biodiversity and ecosystem services

E. Enhance implementation through participatory planning, knowledge management and capacity building

Assessment of NBSAP Implementation

- In **RED**, using the same diagram and scale, indicate the relative completeness of **implementation** of the 5 Goals (0 - not implemented, up to 5 - fully implemented);
- Show your grid to the partner country and discuss/explain your reasoning and results;
- “Volunteer” countries will be asked to present their results to the group.



NBSAP highs and lows

- Finally, identify and write on cards what you consider to be **3 STRONG** and **3 WEAK** points of the:
 - Preparation of your existing NBSAP; and
 - Implementation of your existing NBSAP
- Use one card for NBSAP preparation and another for NBSAP implementation “highs and lows”.
