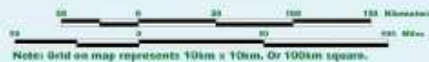
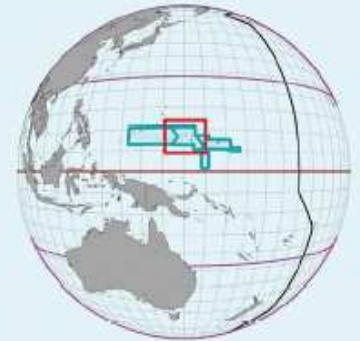
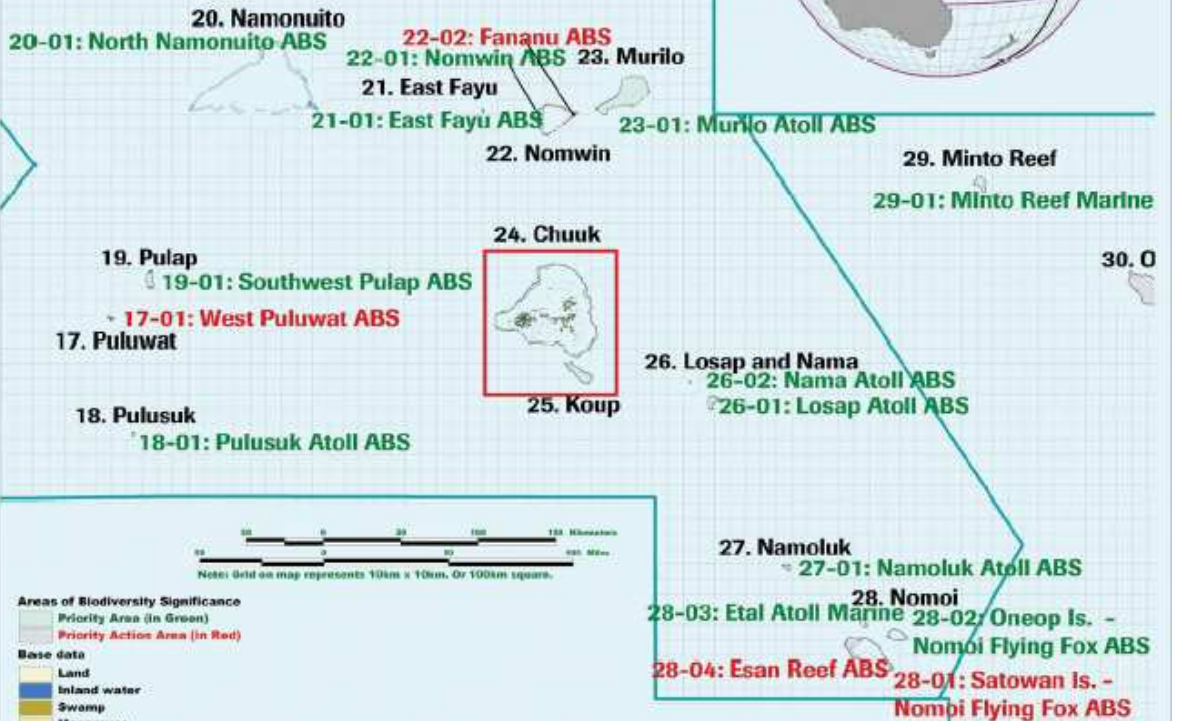
YAP STATE Areas of Biodiversity Significance

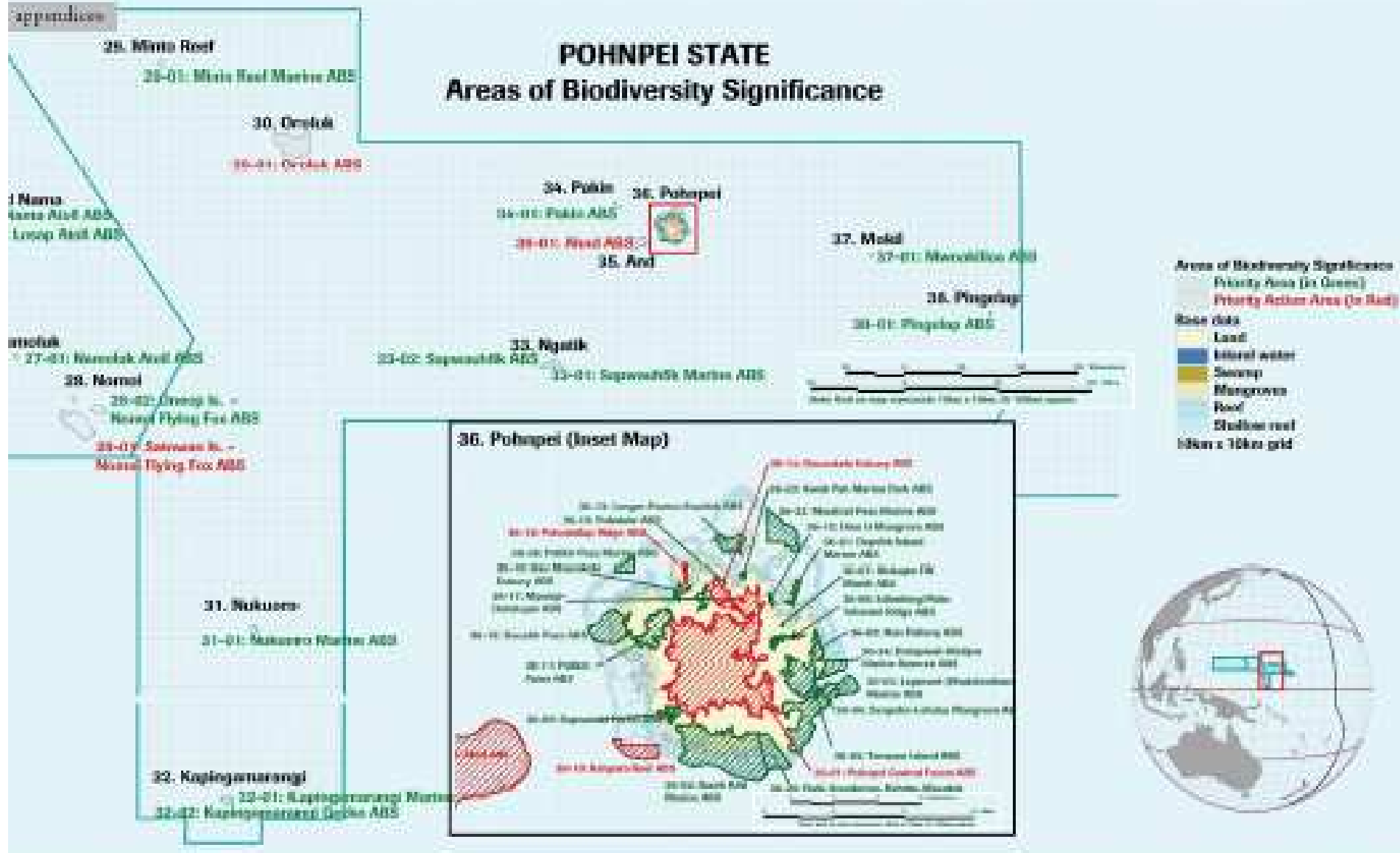

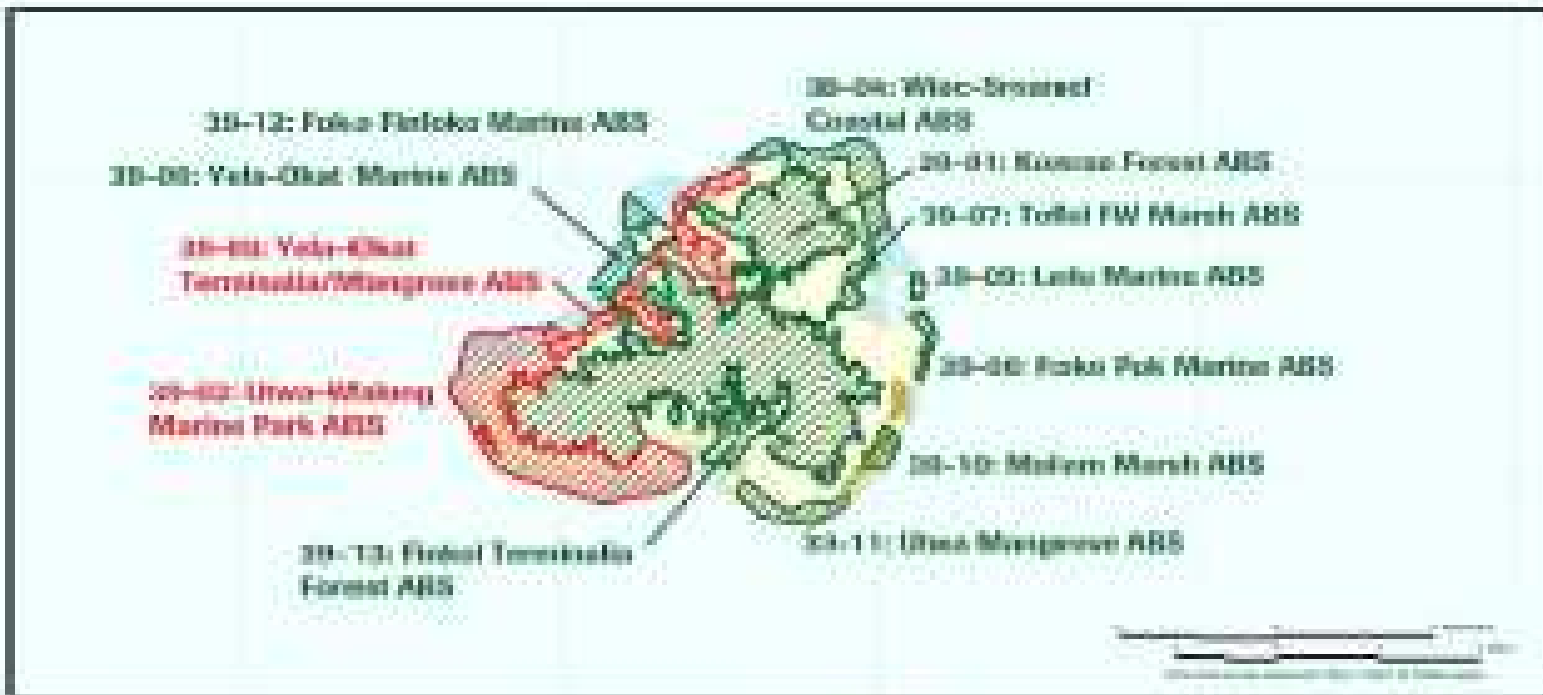

KOSRAE STATE Areas of Biodiversity Significance



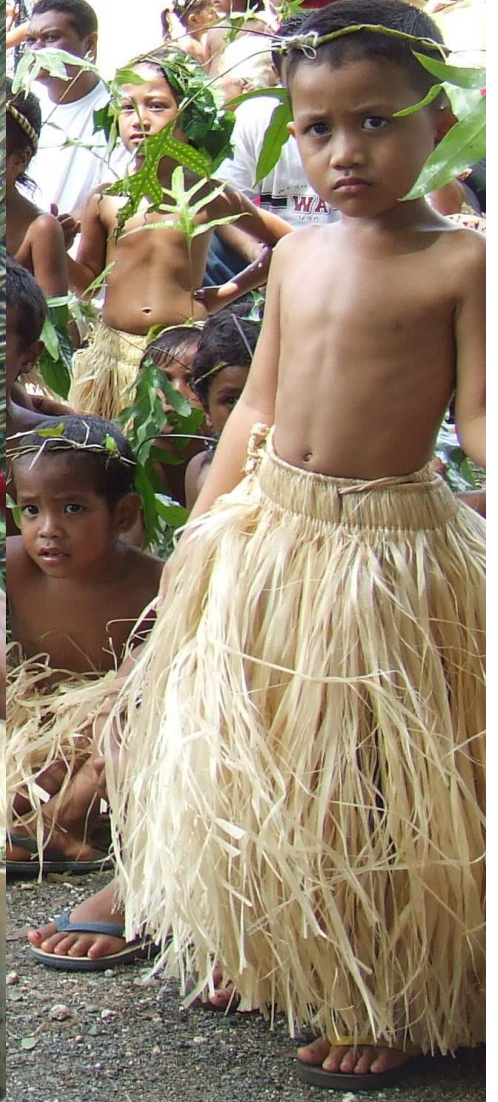

- effectively conserve at least 30% of near-shore marine resources and 20% of terrestrial resources across Micronesia by the year 2020.*

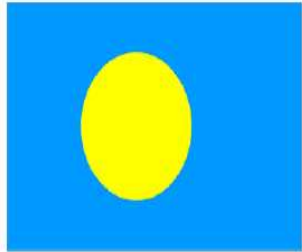
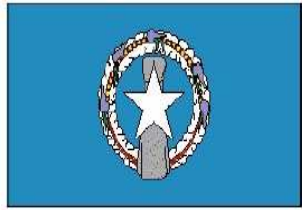
