- Undertake negotiations training and identify opportunities to highlight Pacific positions. (for example, relevant CBD related meetings that the Pacific should engage e.g AHTEGs Working Groups, Expert Groups

### Pacific and COP 10

- Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme
- Need to be vigorous about nominations to these meetings.
  - Some countries are missing out on CBD financial assistance to attend meetings because they are late with their nominations.
- SPREP to look for resources to celebrate Pacific achievements at CoP 10 and 2010: year of biodiversity.
  - Need to develop a strategy document to secure necessary resources to actively engage in CoP 10 and to celebrate 2010.
  - Countries can also use this document for donors to support their involvement in CBD related affairs.
  - Need to clearly identify specific activities for this document.







# Progress to date

- Have secured €40,000 for pre COP activities (Funds Pacifique)
- Presented ideas to SPREP meeting and Roundtable
- Urgent: need to pull together team
- Urgent: Nominations for biodiversity and cc AHTEG
- List server started
- FIELD has funds to run a negotiations workshop in Melanesia (could be expanded)
