Please indicate your intention to present a poster and accompanying two-page abstract by completing and returning the attached form before **29 February 2012**, by fax or email to secretariat@cbd.int. Upon receipt of your form, we will forward detailed guidelines (which are also available on the SBSTTA-16 web pages at: <a href="http://www.cbd.int/sbstta16/poster-session">http://www.cbd.int/sbstta16/poster-session</a>).

Note that posters must demonstrate a close relationship with the theme of this year's poster session and that there will be a limit to the number of posters presented. Participation is not restricted to meeting participants.

The Secretariat of the CBD plans to publish the extended abstracts of the posters in its Technical Series. The deadline for submission of extended abstracts is **26 March 2012**.
