Selected representatives of indigenous peoples and local communities to receive funding for their participation in the Fifth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation, the Sixteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity and the concurrent meetings of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meetings of the Parties to the Cartagena and Nagoya Protocols

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing in connection to notification 2024-038 which invited representatives from indigenous peoples and local communities to submit for consideration a request for financial assistance for their participation in the fifth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation (SBI 5), to take place from 16 to 18 October 2024, as well as in the sixteenth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (COP 16), the eleventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety (COP-MOP 11), and the fifth meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Nagoya Protocol on Access and Benefit-sharing (COP-MOP 5), to be held concurrently from 21 October to 1 November 2024 in Cali, Colombia.

The selection was carried out in accordance with the criteria for the operation of the Voluntary Funding Mechanism to facilitate the participation of indigenous peoples and local communities in the work of the Convention as set out in the annex to decision VIII/5 D, and in accordance with the selection criteria established in section B of the same annex.
