The country identify taxonomy as being a priority for the country since limited work has been done. As a result, the Government in collaboration with certain NGO's would like to get those works done. Earlier this year, the Government in collaboration with an NGO, Plant Conservation Action Group, implemented a workshop to prioritise the needs with regards to the flora of Seychelles. This will lead to the development of a National Plant Strategy which takes onboard the conservation of lichens and fungi, certain species that have always been neglected in the past.

The country has also identified that there is a need to have the capacity locally so as not to rely heavily on foreign expertise.
