The Minister of NRE also hosted a welcoming dinner on the 17th June 2010 for the participants at the Crowne Plaza Mutiara Hotel. The meeting outcome was very positive where most of the texts negotiated were agreed. One more meeting will be held prior to COP 10 in Nagoya this October to conclude the supplementary protocol of liability and redress.

Putrajaya, 22 April - In commemorating Earth Day today, Ministry of Natural Resources dan Environment had launched a nationwide campaign to plant 26 million trees by 2014.

The 26 million trees represent the estimated 26 million population of the country. Some 16,200 saplings were planted in launching the campaign, with 500 planted at a site in Precinct 5 opposite the Putrajaya International Convention Centre (PICC) in Putrajaya.
