

Recycling to the Biodiversity conservation

Alguazas Local Council, Murcia Region (Spain)

The Alguazas Local Council as its Environmental Department has planned actions to the environment education in the local scholar centres on recycling. Activities realized to develop a strong environmental awareness, to encourage sustainable lifestyle and habits, to improve the social engagements towards environ and to involve children to the recycling to the biodiversity conservation.

More then 200 students of primary school, particularly of the Monte Anaor and the Nuestra Señora del Carmen Scholar Centre of Alguazas, took part in two activities area coordinated by the Environmental Department of Alguazas:

Activity 1: audiovisual on the importance of the recycling, reduction of urban waste and reusing, with the collaboration of Proyecto Abraham association.

Activity 2: workshop on biodiversity and waste impact on species and its habitats, the importance of recycling. Furthermore the students visited the Ecoparque of Alguazas Local Council and the know-how of its use. The Ecoparque is a “mobile container” that make easy the selective waste collection to the inhabitant. Moreover the student took part to a workshop reusing a plastic bottle to made feeders to birds. This activity was developed in the framework of the slogan “Many species, a planet, a future”, with the collaboration of emasce.
