Follow up on the IYB 2010 - Final report from the Danish Society for Nature Conservation

Our organization celebrated the international year of biodiversity by:

- In march we launched a new webpage on biodiversity dn.dk/biodiversitet with the purpose of telling the public about biodiversity, biodiversity values, how to protect biodiversity, national initiatives on biodiversity and reporting from the COP 10-meeting in Nagoya
- The 21. May we sent a letter to all mayors of the 98 Danish municipalities signed by our biodiversity-ambassador, the famous Danish writer end entertainer Anders Lund Madsen, that called on the mayors to support the Countdown 2010-initiative and sign a Countdown 2010 declaration
- On the international biodiversity day, 22. May, the 14 green organizations behind "Det Grønne Kontaktudvalg" launched a significant report "Danish Nature 2010 the loss of biodiversity" at a formal reception with participants from the Danish Parliament
- During May, June and September we held 5 courses for citizens and volunteers on how to manage smaller nature conservation sites
- On the 16. October The Danish Society for Nature Conservation along with Svenska Naturskyddsföreningen, Suomen luonnonsuojeluliitto, The Finnish Natur och Miljö, The Norwegian Naturvernforbund, The Faroesee FNU and Landvernd send at common declaration to the governments of the Scandinavian countries and The Nordic Ministerial Council asking for an ambitious agreement at COP 10
- Participated in COP 10 in Nagoya, reporting from negotiations to the public during the meeting.
