## Global News Network to feature the International Year of Biodiversity on cable TV

Biodiversity issues and concerns will be on television when the ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity (ACB) and the Manila-based Global News Network (GNN) launches a monthly cable TV feature on the International Year of Biodiversity (IYB).
