









Terrestrial PA coverage




Marine PA coverage




Key biodiversity areas

Reached 60 % of the PAME assessment target




Key biodiversity areas – Gap No.1

72 % of KBAs are not fully covered by protected areas

- → Bring those areas under PA or OECM
- → Improving PA management
- → Focus on AZEs and IBAs in Danger

Coverage of ecoregions – Gap No.2

- → Further protection of 18 terrestrial ecoregions, 9 marine ecoregions and 5 pelagic provinces as their occurrence in the region is more than 25%, and worldwide protection is less than 17% or 10%.
- → Five terrestiral ecoregions are a high priority, as they have sufficient suitable unprotected land to meet the 17% target without restoration (i.e. they have enough natural habitat remaining, outside of reported PAs).
