Edéhzhíe **Dehcho Protected Area - National Wildlife Area**

(eh - day - shae)

This site, supported by the Nature Fund, is set to become Canada's first Indigenous Protected Area and an example of reconciliation in action. Covering 14,249km² it will be designated as a Dehcho Protected Area and recognized and protected as a National Wildlife Area

Purposes

- Conservation of wildlife and ecological integrity
- Maintain the Dene Edéhzhíe relationship
- Allow for traditional harvesting
- Incorporate Dene language and culture into decisions



Future

An Edéhzhíe Management Board will make management decisions by consensus. A Dehcho K'éhodi Guardians program will employ local Dene to be the eyes and ears of Edéhzhíe.
