They should not be understood as official statements of policy as they will still undergo further discussions at the various levels of authority in the AMS



Current Status

e.g. Coverage of areas for terrestrial and marine PAs

- CAMBODIA Existing Terrestrial PAs 7,412,392.67 ha, approx. 41% (December 2018)
 - Increase 2 new PA in Ramsar sites. 7 other new natural heritage sites (PA) also proposed
 - Existing Marine PA 52,498 ha (August 2018)
 - Increase 2 new CMPAs

INDONESIA - marine MPAs - by 2020, target is at 20 million has; at present they are at 104% realization

- by 2030, target is at 30 million has (300,000 sq.km
- new identified areas to be protected 25, 147.09 sq.km
- CTI 150, 753.22 sq.km

MYANMAR - increase in terrestrial PAs - 4,596.549024 sq.km, for 2019-2020

- increase in marine PAs - 1,818.08667 sq.km, for 2019-2020

THAILAND - increase in marine PAs - 229.124 (sq.km or has, for clarification) (Ko Kra archipelago)







Gaps

Specific gaps identified for elements of Target 11 (e.g. PA coverage, ecological representation, coverage of areas important for biodiversity, etc.)

MYANMAR - 12597.92 sq.km, by 2020-2021

- establish new PAs in under-represented Eco-regions (Taninthayi, Kachin, Kayah, Kayin and Sagaing Regions)

SINGAPORE - connectivity and corridors

- -360km of park connectors
- -100km of Nature Ways
- 200ha of skyrise greenery

What work is ongoing to address specific gaps?

ASEAN Member States, through the units in the appropriate ministries dealing with PAs, are at the moment working to address challenges in implementation arising from Target 11 commitments







Proposed Regional Action Plan (June-Dec 2019)

- A. Fine-tune Priority Action Plans
 - validating the numbers and further specifics from commitments made
- B. Fast-tracking/Regular Monitoring of PAs already in the pipeline
- C. OECM Regional Initiative
 - 1. in-depth seminar on methodologies; technical guidelines
 - 2. inventory of possible areas for consideration as OECMs; including existing approaches like Ramsar declaration, etc.
 - 3. coordinated actions to identify, recognize OECMs by Oct 2020
- C. Resource Mobilization
 - 1. Refine funding requests made
 - 2. Package the funding requests into specific proposals; secure funding and provide to requesting AMS
- D. Expert Pooling and Deployment
 - 1. Prioritize requests for technical support
 - 2. Identify technical groups/institutions willing to provide technical assistance
 - 3. Deployment to Requesting country







Ideas for Monitoring

Ideas for monitoring

- agreering on the specific data sets to be monitored
- pinpointing the right official with sufficient level of authority who may be willing to provide information
- global datasets may be presented for validation
- putting together all other types of information from various sources







WAY FORWARD?

CBD Secretariat to continuously cajole and request CBD Parties for action

Regional Implementation Support hubs can only do so much, perhaps communication/notification from ES and posted in CBD website may help and other compliance mechanisms

submission of lessons learned and subsequent actions to post-2020
